

Short Introduction of Directorate of Works & Plants

This Directorate had been established in the year 1979. It mainly looks after construction of new buildings, internal roads, renovation of old construction works at Main Campus, Crop Research Stations and Krishi Vigyan Kendras located in different districts of Eastern Uttar Pradesh under the jurisdiction of the university as well as civil and electrical maintenance of the entire campus. Besides, it looks after water supply system and sanitary works of the main campus. The directorate is headed by Director of Works & Plants and supported by one Executive Engineer (Civil), two Assistant Engineers (Civil), one Assistant Engineer (Elect.), one Computer Engineer, five Junior Engineers (Civil), one Junior Engineer (Elect.), two draughts men, one Divisional Accountant, one Accountant, two Stenographers, one Tracer, one Store Keeper, one Meter Reader, 5 Junior Clerks, two Electricians, one Wireman, one Linemen, three Pump Operators, two Plumbers, two Artisons, four Mates, two Attendants, one Messenger and other casual labours monitors closely the civil and electrical works allotted to various Govt. Construction Agencies of Uttar Pradesh, who carry out the construction works of the University in Campus as well as out of Campus. Major funding agencies are State Government of Uttar Pradesh and ICAR, New Delhi.

Major activities from October 2017 to till date

A- Completed Works:

1. Construction work of College of Agriculture at Kotwa, Azamgarh with a sanctioned cost of Rs.70.22 crores have been completed. University has taken handover of this college, in which teaching activities have been started from current session.

- 2. The work of establishment of an additional Transformer of 5MV capacity in the existing 33/11 KV Sub Station of the University with a sanctioned cost of Rs.1.49 crores have been completed and is in use now.
- 3. An Auditorium of 484 person's capacity constructed under the College of Agri. Business Management has been furnished completely and handed over to the university. The present 20th Convocation of the university is going to be organized on 6th September, 2018 in this Auditorium.
- 4. International Hostel Cum VIP Guest House having 16 suites and 34 single rooms have been made functional.

B-Ongoing Works:

- 1. Construction work of College of Agriculture at Gonda have been started in the month of December 2015 with a sanctioned cost of Rs.28.06 crores against which Rs.13.00 crores have been received from State Government so far. At present finishing work in the Main College Building and Foundation work in Hostel Building is in progress.
- 2. Construction work of 2nd phase of Boys hostel and other allied works at College of Agriculture, Azamgarh was started in the month of March 2017 with sanctioned cost of Rs.13.92 crores against which State Government has provided Rs.9.00 crores so far. The construction work is in full swing and targeted to be completed by December, 2018.
- 3. In order to fulfill the norms of Veterinary Council of India in College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh has sanctioned the required



- balance work amounting Rs.3.99 crores against which full funds have been provided by the State Government. Construction work is in full swing and likely to be completed by March, 2019.
- 4. The construction work of Processing Plant and Storage Godown with a cost of Rs.35.00 lakh under Seed Hub Project has been started in the month of July, 2018.
- 5. Construction of Farm Pond for Rain water Harvesting at Agronomy Farm with a cost of Rs. 8.00 lakh is going to be started.
- 6. ICAR has sanctioned five new KVKs in Amethi, Bahraich, Gonda, Sultanpur and Jaunpur districts under the Administrative Control of this University. The estimates for construction of Main Building at KVK-Amethi and Bahraich has been sent to ICAR for providing sanctions. For the rest KVKs the process is in progress.
- 7. The process of construction of Rainout Shelter with a cost of Rs.2.85 lakh under RKVY is in progress.
